New Watering Restrictions from the St. Johns River Water Management District (SJRWMD)

When you set your clocks back one hour on November 1st, with the return to Eastern Standard Time, it is also the time to reduce your lawn and landscape irrigation to no more than one day a week.

The St. Johns River Water Management District's new watering restrictions became effective earlier this year. Lawn watering has been limited to two (2) designated days per week since daylight saving time took effect on March 8.

Eastern Standard Time begins on November 1st, and with it comes a seasonal change in the watering restrictions. Lawns need much less water in the cooler months because of winter dormancy. To reflect this reduced need, lawn watering will be limited to **no more than one (1) day per week until the return of daylight saving time.**

- Homes with addresses that end in an **odd number or have no address may water only on Saturdays.**
- Homes with addresses that end in an **even number may only water on Sundays.**
- Nonresidential irrigation is allowed **only on Tuesdays.**

Watering is allowed **only before 10 a.m. or after 4 p.m. year-round.** Some exceptions to the restrictions apply.
