I. Roll Call

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. Bruce Manne, William Masters, Skeeter Surguine, and Michelle Widick were present. Joe Wisniewski was excused. Staff members present were Brian Rademacher, Economic Development Director; Steven Lichliter, Airport Manager; and Terri Hamsher, Recording Secretary.

II. Approval of Minutes

Dr. Manne moved and Mr. Masters seconded approval of the January 10, 2022 minutes.

III. Review of the Proposed Airport Capital Improvements Program

Mr. Lichliter reviewed the Proposed Airport CIP, which included the projects: Wildlife Mitigation & Security; Rehabilitate, Mark and Light Taxiway "E"; Rehabilitate Taxiway Bravo Apron & Ramp Area; and, Airport Tower Handrail Replacement.

The Aviation Advisory Board recommended approval of the Proposed Airport Capital Improvements Program. Mr. Master moved, and Mr. Surguine seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

IV. Audience Comments

Connie Colby

Ms. Colby spoke on the fencing and the concern with the property survey. Ms. Colby also spoke on using the Bill for the bipartisan infrastructure law to repay the City general funds that had been used for the airport. Ms. Colby asked about the airport fund goals and the Riverbend Golf Course lease agreement.

Fran Canfield
136 Bear Creek Path

Ms. Canfield asked that the council listen to citizens, and spoke against the runway extension, that it would not reduce the noise level and not benefit everyone. Ms. Canfield requested that the council look at other ways to grow Ormond and made various suggestions.

Sharon Trescott
689 Pineland Trail

Ms. Trescott spoke regarding questions she asked staff that were not answered, a meeting request that was denied. She mentioned the OB Life meeting on the airport. Ms. Trescott asked about the obstructions that are known and how they affect her property. Ms. Trescott talked about the ALP, and the airport

boundary line and her property. Ms. Trescott requested a meeting with citizens that would allow them more than a few minutes to speak about the airport.

Mr. Echelberry spoke on the noise abatement task force, aircraft noise complaints he made to the Airport Manager, and the FAA. Mr. Echelberry also spoke regarding the process of not being able to get a copy of the board minutes until after they are approved by the board.

Mr. Miller spoke on the Riverbend Golf Course and the FAA guidelines as regards sale or development of the property. Mr. Miller spoke on email correspondence he had regarding the golf course property and the golf course closing.
