Chief explained PSI Level 1 and Level 2 and those levels being in the Administrative Investigation Policy and not being our decision.

PSI 23-001

Comment was made that the complainant went overboard about the officer, and why did she act that way. Chief advised we don't know why people do what they do. All we do is go on a fact-finding investigation and find out what happened, a lot was reviewed on body camera and a lot of what was said did not happen. Comment was made that the BWC's are a great asset to the Police Department.

PSI 22-006

Comment about a Citizen was left with a bad feeling with the Police Department. Capt. Roos Advised she was found at fault. Capt. Roos advised the Officer has discretion on whether or not to write a citation or not. If you take away our discretion then we no longer have it and that's one of our options. Capt. Smith advised there is certain criteria for a crash report and we give them all the options. Capt. Roos advised sometimes it's a no-win situation. At the end of the day the complaint was unfounded.
