



**LONG SHORE AND HARBOR NOTICE:**

**Permits for docks, seawalls, boatlifts or any other permits where it may be necessary to work over the water (such as, but not limited to barges and boats) must have the following notice signed and dated by the contractor and owner at the time the permit is submitted for review.**

**“Federal law entitles certain land based employees engaged in work adjacent to navigable waters, including but not limited to construction workers on docks, to compensation for work related injuries. Accordingly, you may need to obtain insurance coverage under the Longshore and Harbor Workers’ Compensation Act 33 U.S.C. 901, ET.SEQ”**
