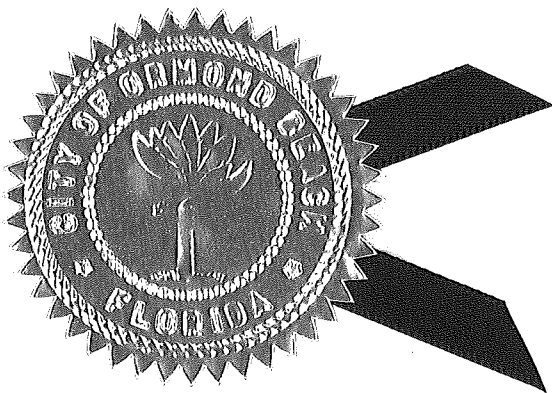
WHEREAS, women need to take action to make heart health a priority for themselves and their families, become aware of their heart disease risk, and take action to control their risk;
