

**ORMOND BEACH  
AVIATION ADVISORY BOARD  
REGULAR MEETING**

**I. Roll Call**

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. Bob Behnke, Sam Hamilton, Bruce Manne, Larry Stout and Larry Volenec were present. Staff members present were Steven Lichliter, Airport Manager and Terri Hamsher, Recording Secretary.

**II. Administrative Matters**

Dr. Manne nominated and Mr. Behnke seconded to select Mr. Stout as Chairman. Mr. Hamilton nominated and Mr. Volenec seconded to select Dr. Manne as Vice-Chairman. Both nominations passed unanimously.

**III. Approval of Minutes**

Dr. Manne moved and Mr. Behnke seconded approval of the October 14, 2013, minutes, the motion passed unanimously.

**IV. Noise Issues**

Mr. Lichliter shared with the board that noise issues continued to be less of a concern and were minimal. He received complaints from two individuals, one from Tomoka Estates and one from Ormond Crossings. He noted that the flight schools were being cooperative in reminding their students about the noise.

Mr. Lichliter noted that air traffic in 2013 was higher than in 2012. At the end of 2012 there were 115,000 operations compared to 126,000 at the end of 2013. The board discussed the reasons for the increase in air traffic.

**V. Projects Updates**

Mr. Lichliter advised the board that the Taxiway A project was complete and provided details on the Taxiway G project, including the grant funding received for this project. He also spoke on the airport tower funding and the upgrade to the systems in the tower.

Mr. Lichliter shared with the board that the instrument approaches were not working at the airport. He discussed the survey the GIS Division was working on regarding obstructions at the airport. He also spoke on the proposal for the wireless facilities at the airport. He mentioned that the FAA might be interested in possibly installing equipment at the airport on a temporary basis. The board discussed the site obstruction and the FAA.

Other items discussed were a possible lease of lot 3 of the Southeast Quad, the fuel farm, and enhancement of the Airport's webpage.
