

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Civil Air Patrol (CAP) is a voluntary service organization with three primary missions: Aerospace Education, Cadet Programs, and Emergency Services; and

WHEREAS, CAP has held a permanent presence in the community of Ormond Beach since December 1966, when the city leased to CAP a parcel of land upon which the existing CAP hangar facility was constructed at the Ormond Beach Municipal Airport; and

WHEREAS, the CAP Cadet Color Guard program prepares cadets to serve as color guards and honor guards while simultaneously furthering their individual character development; and

WHEREAS, the Ormond Beach CAP Cadet Color Guard Team competed successfully against eight other teams and won six trophies, including first place overall, at the 2014 CAP Florida Wing Cadet Competition at Patrick Air Force Base; and

WHEREAS, the Ormond Beach CAP Cadet Color Guard Team represented Florida and competed successfully against teams from three other states and won seven trophies, including first place overall, at the 2014 CAP Southeast Region Cadet Competition at Maxwell Air Force Base in Alabama; and

WHEREAS, as a result of their victory at the regional competition, the Ormond Beach cadets will have the honor to serve the entire CAP Southeast Region at the Southeast Region Conference in Atlanta, Georgia, and will also help train other cadets at the CAP Honor Guard Academy in Tennessee and the Color Guard Academy at Patrick Air Force Base; and

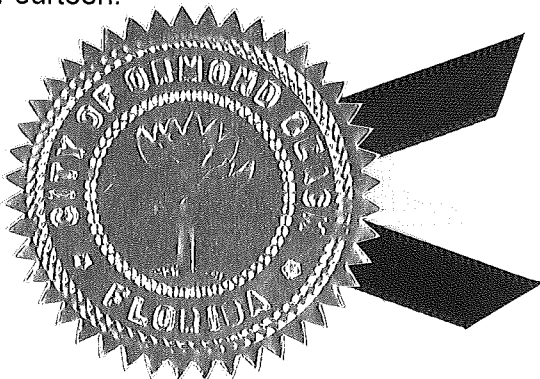
