WHEREAS, Guy Eby was born in Ephrata, Pennsylvania on November 9, 1918 and made Ormond Beach his home in 1983. He has four children: Robert, Wayne, Penny, and Paula; and

WHEREAS, Guy served in the Armed Forces of the United States for eight years as a Navy pilot; and

WHEREAS, Guy was a commercial pilot with American Airlines for twenty-eight years and retired with a stellar flight record; and

WHEREAS, Forty-three years ago Guy saved his passengers from what would have been the largest mid-air collision in U.S history by maneuvering an American Airlines DC-10 out of the path of a TWA L-1011 after a mistake was made by an air traffic controller; and

WHEREAS, Guy served as both a member and the chairman of the Ormond Beach Airport Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, Guy recently celebrated his 100th birthday on November 9, 2018.
