Beginner's Nature Drawing Class

On Saturday, August 24, the Environmental Discovery Center (EDC) presented a class for those interested in learning more about how to improve their skills in drawing all things in nature.

Artist Laura Doig led a group of eight enthusiastic participants in a program that covered drawing techniques and practice in using those techniques. Laura gave tips on how to really “see” what is being drawn. For example, just simply holding up a drawing pencil to the object to get a sense of the size/scale so the artist can transfer the results of that observation to their drawing. She also covered shading and the proper way to use a pencil to reflect a three dimensional effect.

The group went outside to practice their “seeing” technique and then came back inside to draw palm trees using the tips gained from Laura. The drawings they produced were all very good.

ORMOND BEACH— The 37th Citizen Police Academy is currently enrolling adults who are at least 18 years old. The class will meet 6pm – 8pm every Thursday from September 5th to October 3rd at the Ormond Beach Police Department (170 W. Granada Blvd. Ormond Beach, FL). The program is free of charge, dinner and refreshments will be served.

The Citizen Police Academy is a program designed to acquaint individuals who are not sworn police officers with the activities of their local police department. The program is a five-week course designed to give the community an inside look at the duties of law enforcement officers. Through participation in lectures, demonstrations, tours and hands-on opportunities; citizens will gain valuable insight into the policies and procedures of the Ormond Beach Police Department. Community involvement is the most powerful force any law enforcement agency has in the fight against crime. For the community to be effective, it is important that its citizens understand the challenges that the police officers face daily. Participants have the opportunity to participate in a ride along with a patrol officer.

Participation in the Ormond Beach CPA program offers citizens the opportunity to explore the different aspects of law enforcement in a series of weekly educational sessions covering topics like Active Shooter Response, DUI Investigations, Traffic Investigations, Crime Scene Investigations, Patrol Operation and Criminal Investigations. By participating in the CPA program the citizen will gain a better sense of trust in their police department.
