I. Roll Call

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Sam Hamilton, Bruce Manne, William Masters, Skeeter Surgine and Joe Wisniewski were present. Staff members present were Gabe Menendez, Public Works Director; Steven Lichliter, Airport Manager, and Terri Hamsher, Recording Secretary.

II. Approval of Minutes

The August 5, 2019, minutes were unanimously approved as typed.

III. Noise Abatement

Mr. Lichliter advised the board that there were several noise complaints, some complaints he received while out of town and one of which was of a threatening nature. He noted that most of the complaints were from the southeast area of the river. He advised the board that he followed up on all of the complaints and reached out to the flight schools several times regarding the noise issues. Mr. Lichliter advised the board that October is a busy month with flight training for the flight schools and added that overall, the flight schools are doing a better job and traffic is down significantly over the last ten years.

Mr. Lichliter mentioned to the board that the FAA may want to extend the tower hours to 9:00 p.m., which is two hours later than it currently is.

A discussion ensued regarding noise and tower hours.

IV. Projects Updates

Mr. Lichliter provided an update on the runway extension for Runway 9 and Taxiway A; the perimeter access roads; security improvements; Taxiways B, D, E rehabilitation; and, directory signage.

Mr. Lichliter displayed various maps while discussing the different projects.
