

Voter and Election Information Resources FAQs

Where can I find information on voter demographics?

Voter demographic information can be obtained from the Volusia County Supervisor of Elections. Currently available voter demographic analysis can be found at the Department of Elections webpage's Voter Registration Statistics and Reports' section: http://www.volusiaelections.org/VoterRegistration/reg_stat.htm.

For reference, District Demographic Analysis for Ormond Beach and Ormond Beach Commission zones is provided in this section. This report is available on the above referenced website.

How can I request registered voter information?

Voter information may be requested from the Volusia County Supervisor of Elections. Information can be requested by mailing or faxing the Voter Registration Order Form, which is included in this section. This form can also be completed online at the Volusia County Department of Elections' public records section of their website at <http://volusiaelections.org/Candidates/publicrecords.htm>.

How much does it cost to obtain this information and in what ways can it be obtained?

May I make a public records request for election related information?

What is a poll watcher?

A poll watcher is a person designated by a candidate, political party, or political committee to *watch* and *observe* the conduct of elections. Poll watchers are not paid for their services by the Department of Elections or the City Clerk. More information about poll watchers is included in this section. How do I designate a poll watcher?

Poll watchers are designated by completing the Designation of Poll Watchers form (DS-DE 125) included in this section and submitting it to the Supervisor of Elections.
