

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, veterans hold a special place in the hearts of citizens across this country. Many who served their country in the United States Armed Forces took the skills and experience they developed on the battlefield and applied them to a life of service here at home. We live in freedom today because of their sacrifices; and

WHEREAS, Paul McCauley is a veteran living in Ormond Beach. Paul joined the Air Force in 1960 and was assigned frequent eight-hour flying missions while stationed in England. As a result of those flying missions, he eventually suffered permanent vision loss. Paul was discharged in 1970 and started serving veterans as a civilian. His passion for disabled veterans led him to start the America's Sensory Impaired Veterans Organization Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Paul is married to Linda and they have lived in Ormond Beach for decades. Paul cares deeply about his community and has looked for ways to serve his community over the years, which included running for City Commissioner in 1999 and 2005. Paul has served the City of Ormond Beach in the past by volunteering his time on the Quality of Life Advisory Board, the Environmental Advisory Board, and Development Review Board. Paul also served his community as Commander of the Cassin Young Memorial Post 267 of the American Legion, and as the Chairman of the Ormond Beach Memorial Day Remembrance Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Ormond Beach Memorial Day Remembrance Committee works in conjunction with the City of Ormond Beach each year on the Memorial Day ceremony. Jim Bowers, the new Chair of the Committee, commended Paul for his service and noted that *"Paul's leadership while serving as the Chairman for the last 22 years has made this annual event what it is today."*
