

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution was founded on October 11, 1890, to perpetuate the memory and the spirit of the men and women who achieved American Independence, to promote the development of an enlightened public opinion, and to foster patriotic citizenship; and

WHEREAS, the Captain James Ormond Chapter of the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution was organized in 1966, in Ormond Beach, Volusia County, Florida. The Chapter was named for Captain James Ormond, whose family settled in Volusia County around 1790; and

WHEREAS, September 17, 2020, marks the two hundred and thirty-third anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary, and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17th through 23rd as "Constitution Week";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Partington, Mayor of the City of Ormond Beach, do hereby proclaim September 17-23, 2020, as "Constitution Week" and as a time to celebrate with the
