

# PROCLAMATION

**WHEREAS**, the City of Ormond Beach has a rich history of honoring our veterans, including Memorial Day and Veteran's Day celebrations and events recognizing World War II, Korean War, and Vietnam Veterans. In August of 2018, the City Commission approved a program designed to honor and pay tribute to Ormond Beach's military heroes for their sacrifice and service to our country in the nation's armed services. The Hometown Heroes Military Appreciation Banner program allows Ormond Beach residents to honor family members that are active duty, were honorably discharged, or those who were killed in the line of duty; and

**WHEREAS**, Halifax Health has shown devotion to our community in the past by partnering with the City of Ormond Beach. Halifax Health is continuing their commitment to sponsor the Hometown Heroes program, and we applaud their support of our military and veterans; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Ormond Beach will publicly express their gratitude to those 105 service members selected by displaying prominent double-sided banners saluting them across the Granada Bridge throughout the month of November. Each banner will have a photo of the individual, their branch of service, and rank and years of service; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to pay tribute to these service personnel and recognize their commitment to our nation and community, there will be an annual ceremony each November to honor those selected service members and their families. Each family or honoree will receive a keepsake replica banner of the one displayed on the Granada Bridge, as a constant reminder of the honoree's service to our great country. This year, the City of Ormond Beach will honor the service members with a "drive-through" event at the Performing Arts Center; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Bill Partington, Mayor of the City of Ormond Beach, do hereby proclaim the month of November 2020, as a time to celebrate Ormond Beach's
