I. Roll Call

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Sam Hamilton, Bruce Manne, Skeeter Surguine, and Joe Wisniewski were present. William Masters was not present. Staff members present were Brian Rademacher, Economic Development Director, Steven Lichliter, Airport Manager, and Terri Hamsher, Recording Secretary.

II. Approval of Minutes

The July 13, 2020, minutes were unanimously approved as typed.

III. Noise Abatement

Mr. Lichliter spoke on the number of increased calls from citizens about noise concerns. He received calls from citizens in the Bear Creek, Ormond Lakes, Tomoka Estates and Northbrook subdivisions. Mr. Lichliter shared that the increase of noise could be due to construction projects at the Flagler and Daytona airports.

Mr. Lichliter spoke on flight tracking software.

Mr. Lichliter provided information on noise abatement procedures while displaying various maps.

The board discussed noise abatement and flight patterns.
