General Parade Information

Cash Awards & Prizes: Each of the (3) three categories will be judged for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. Winners will receive: 1st Place \$150 * 2nd Place \$100 * 3rd Place \$50. A single, overall prize for "BEST OF SHOW" will receive \$200. All winners in all categories are required to submit a W-9 before payment can be made. Awards will be presented at a designated City Commission meeting after the parade.

Presidents Cup Award: The Presidents Cup is an award geared toward the business community. In partnership with the Ormond Beach Chamber of Commerce, the parade is giving the Presidents Cup to the best decorated float from a business entry. The Presidents Cup Trophy will be awarded at a designated City Commission Meeting after the Parade and will be passed from year to year to the selected winning business.

Parade Route: The Parade route will be on the mainland side of Ormond Beach, approximately 1.5 miles long. When planning your entry please give consideration to your participants. Parade starts at Division Ave. and Ridgewood Ave. (US 1), goes north to Granada Blvd., turns east on Granada Blvd. to Beach Street, turns south on Beach Street ending in front of City Hall at the review area.

Parade Staging Area: The staging area is located on and around Division Ave. You will report to your designated division that will be marked by yellow, green, red or blue strobe lights and signage. A confirmation will be sent to you prior to the parade date assigning your group to a specific color staging area and specific directions how to get there. Parade staff in reflective safety vests will direct you to your lineup position. Many streets will be closed to traffic and parking will be limited. Please allow yourself ample time to arrive and set-up by 5:30 pm.

Parade Disbanding Area: All walking groups, after passing the reviewing stand, proceed south on Beach Street to Tomoka Ave., head west to City Hall / Library parking lot for pickup. All floats and vehicular displays should continue on Beach Street back to Division Ave.

<u>Judging:</u> Entries will be judged in (1) one category only (float, walkers or vehicle). Some of the criteria the judges will be scoring are: representation of the holiday spirit, over/under performance time, use of holiday music, creativity, lighting, special effects and presentation.

All applications are subject to review for participation by the Home for the Holidays Parade Committee.

Parade Rules and Regulations

<u>Application Accepted Until: THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 30, 2017</u> *Limited Entries*— Due to the popularity & extreme length of past parades we will limit the parade entries.

<u>Lighting of your Entry</u>: Being a nighttime parade the Department of Transportation requires that ALL entries must be lighted in some manner (lights, flashlights, glow in the dark items, etc) to participate in the parade, including all walkers, floats, vehicles, boats, tow units, etc.

<u>Decoration of Entries</u>: All parade entries need to be decorated in an appropriate, tasteful, and festive manner to promote the holiday spirit.

Animals Entries: Must have a clean-up system to ensure proper disposal of waste products. Please ensure the safety of others and your animals.

<u>Floats and Vehicles</u>: Drivers are cautioned to be on the alert for children, other pedestrians, any overhanging trees or lines in the area. No child under (13) years old may ride on floats or in the back of vehicles without adult supervision. Entry number has to be placed on the outside of the passenger side windshield.

Operating Procedure: Please maintain a distance of 20 feet behind the unit in front of you. Parade Marshals along the route will inform you if you are too close or too far away. Please, no slowing or stopping for photographs or performances once the parade starts. If your unit becomes disabled, pull to one side to allow the rest of the parade to proceed around you. If able, you can re-enter the parade with the assistance of the Parade Marshals.

<u>Time to be in Position:</u> We will be prejudging entries in certain criteria. All entries must be in position by 5:30 pm to be included in the prejudging activities. Performances will not be judged at this time.

No Entry May Feature Santa Claus: The City of Ormond Beach provides a Santa for the Holiday Parade. Therefore, no other Santa may be featured. Thank you for your cooperation!

No entry may dispense, throw or toss any items, of any nature, from floats or vehicles. You may use walkers to hand out items only! Our children are very precious to us — please do not encourage them to come to the road for any reason.
