The OB Life Second Meeting to Highlight Transportation & Livable Communities

The City of Ormond Beach is continuing to involve residents in charting its future as The OB Life Community Engagement series continues on Tuesday, July 24, at 6 p.m. This month's meeting focuses on Transportation and Livable Communities. This second meeting in the monthly series also builds on the strong citizen engagement at The OB Life kickoff meeting in June where more than 250 residents and business owners took part.

A Livable community – as defined by a study by AARP – is a community that is safe and secure, has affordable and appropriate housing and transportation options, and offers supportive community features and services. The workshop will touch on all aspects, with a focus on how transportation is the key to connecting all services. Information from the meeting will be shared with Ormond Beach elected leaders who will be updating the city's strategic plan in 2019.

This is an opportunity to learn more about all aspects of transportation and to provide ideas and input about how we tackle the traffic and connectivity in the future. From roads to sidewalks to bike and walking trails, we know it is important to connect all areas of our community.

Following the format of the first meeting, the audience will hear useful information and take part in a question and answer session. Attendees will be asked to anonymously respond to polling questions, followed by table discussions. All information from the meeting, including a video and responses to questions, will be posted on the city's website, OrmondBeach.org.

Posting all information from the meetings is part of the city's ongoing commitment to transparency. Information posted online from the first meeting includes: a copy of the presentation, polling questions and results, questions submitted by attendees and written responses from city staff and a link to a video recording of the meeting and future meeting dates.

The July 24, OB Life community meeting will be held at the Calvary Christian Academy Kids Center, 1687 W. Granada Blvd, starting at 6 p.m., with an anticipated end time of 8 p.m. For more information, visit OrmondBeach.org. Additional handicapped accessible parking will be identified.
