Application for Community and Recognition Awards

The Friends of Recreation in Ormond Beach was established in 1984 by citizens of Ormond Beach. It is a registered Not for Profit Corporation whose purpose is to maintain the association of persons interested in recreation; to focus public attention on recreation; to stimulate the use of recreation resources and services; to receive and encourage gifts, endowments and bequests to recreation; and to support and cooperate with the Leisure Services Advisory Board and the Leisure Services Department for the purpose of developing recreation services and facilities for the community.

Recognition Award: This award will be used to help offset registration cost up to the amount of \$200, and will recognize one male and one female applicant per season of recreational/competitive play. To be eligible to receive this award:

- one must be between the ages of 6 – 18 years old,
- reside in the city of Ormond Beach,
- be active in city sponsored programs.
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Award recipients will be expected to attend a public meeting showcasing their award and achievements.

Deadlines

Spring – January 1
Summer – June 1

Fall - August 1
Winter – November 1

Community Award: This award is used to assist those requesting funds to promote community projects/organizations, or teams with special needs, or teams with post season play with a heavy burden. The applicant may be asked to provide additional information for proper evaluation. Eligibility requirements include:

- organization exists within the City of Ormond Beach
- promotes community
- benefits the citizens of Ormond Beach

Awards distributed to enhance the community may be requested at any time throughout the fiscal year. Monies allotted are determined by the Board of Friends of Recreation based on need and available funds.
